HOW TO APPLY

Check the 'How to apply' page on www.windesheim.com to read the step-bystep procedure. This will direct you to www.studielink.nl, the Dutch national enrolment system, to start your application. We select a maximum of 80 students per year on a first come first served basis. Application deadline for all students: 1 June. We strongly advise you to apply as soon as possible. You can apply even if you are not yet in possession of your diploma.

Admission Requirements

- Admission essay and personal interview
- Diploma equivalent to Dutch mbo4, havo or vwo diploma:
 - · International Baccalaureate
 - · Fachhochschulreife or Abitur
- English Proficiency: havo/vwo/IB/Abitur a pass or: Cambridge B2 / IELTS 6.5 / TOEFL internet 90, paper 575
- A pass in mathematics
