## Admission Requirements

- ✓ Dutch students: mbo4, havo or vwo (havo C+M with Ec, MO, Be, WiA or WiB)
- ✓ International students: equivalent diploma, e.g.:
  - International or European Baccalaureate Diploma
  - Fachhochschulreife or Abitur
- ✓ International students: proficient in English at B2 level (IELTS 6.0, TOEFL: internet 80, paper 550)
- ✓ Preferably a pass in economics and mathematics

## Student Finance System / Scholarship

**Application deadline:** for Dutch students preferably before 1 May, ultimately 31 August, for EU/EEA students 15 June and for Non-EU/EEA students 1 June. You don't have to finish high school before applying.
